Each session will have 3+ speakers, who are leading experts in their fields of phospholipid science. The program gives time for meeting experts and communication with colleagues.

>> WELCOME TO COLOGNE

Cologne is the fourth-largest city in Germany. It is one of the oldest German cities and dates back to Roman times. The Romans founded the Ubii village on the Rhine in 50 AD and named it "Colonia".

With a population of more than one million, Cologne has become one of the most important centres for economy, trade and science in central Europe. In 1388, the citizens of Cologne founded the first city university in Europe, and it is now one of the largest universities in Germany with over 49,000 students.

Today, as in Roman times, the city is one of the most important traffic hubs in Western Europe: all high-speed trains stop here and travellers can fly to more than 130 destinations around the world from Cologne-Bonn Airport.

The magnificent Cologne Cathedral hovers above the roofs and chimneys of the city. It is not only used as a point of orientation but is the pride of the people in Cologne. It can be seen from nearly every point in the city centre and from many places elsewhere.


